Membership

All members of M.R.F.A. for its training sessions will be paid via a monthly direct debit.

Cancellation Policy

By agreeing to set up a direct debit you consent to agree that you will provide M.R.F.A. with 30 days clear notice of any cancellation of our services and will be responsible for payment up to and including this period even if you cancel your direct debit.

Cancellation of Sessions

M.R.F.A. sessions are only cancelled if the facilities are closed by the venue providers, unforeseen certain circumstances such as a global pandemic, or if the weather is unfavourable for outdoor sessions, such as lightning, heavy rain and thunder. You will be notified via email and/or text message on the day the session is taking place (or earlier) if a cancellation is to occur.

Newsletter Subscription

We will not spam you and send you email marketing by way of newsletters/offers etc., unless you agree to receive email marketing by checking the box upon signing up to M.R.F.A.'s training sessions. However, from time-to-time we may send emails to notify you of changes to our sessions, such as cancellations (see above).

Consent for Photographs and Videography

From time to time, M.R.F.A. uses photographs and videos of training sessions and games. By enrolling your child onto our course, you accept that photographs and videos may be taken during our sessions. These videos and photos may be used in future publications such as M.R.F.A. leaflets, flyers, websites, social media and other promotional material.
